## **Catering Team Leader**

Line Manager: Canteen Manager

The Director of Finance & Operations is Leader of the Support Staff and is responsible for the whole team

£ 18 250 per annum 37.5 hours per week, 43.5 weeks per year

The successful candidate will be required to provide a high-quality catering service which supports the wellbeing of pupils and staff. This includes meeting school catering and health and safety standards

#### **Expectations**

#### Meal planning and provision

- Prepare and oversee the provision of high-quality school meals in line with government guidelines and legislation on school nutrition standards
- Serving of staff and students
- Manage and ordering of food stocks to prevent shortages or excess supply
- Cater to special dietary requirements and ensure that allergy information is effectively communicated and labelled
- Assist with stock takes

#### **Staff supervision**

- Team leader for canteen
- Supervise canteen staff
- Assist with staff planning to ensure canteen is adequately staffed
- Assist the Canteen manager with the preparation of duty rotas
- Support the canteen manager

#### Health and safety

- To be aware of health and hygiene responsibilities
- Perform first aid duties as and when required
- Ensure that the kitchen and dining area are kept clean and hygienic
- Ensure that kitchen equipment is used safely and according to operating manuals
- Report necessary repairs to be carried out to ensure the safe running of kitchen equipment to the canteen manager

- Ensure that canteen staff are adhering to proper hygiene procedures, including wearing the correct uniform
- Record all accidents and incidents

## Safeguarding

- Work in line with statutory safeguarding guidance (including Keeping Children Safe in Education) and the school's safeguarding and child protection policies
- Promote the safeguarding of all pupils in the school
