The Chalfonts Community College Governing Board is seeking to appoint two new governors to support the governing board with its strategic leadership of the school, accountability and oversight of operational and financial performance, and positive engagement with all stakeholders.

Governors are not involved with the day-to-day running of the school, but rather support and challenge the School's Leadership Team to drive school improvement and fulfil the school's vision of a happy, successful, and aspirational community, both today and tomorrow.

Being a school governor is a challenging but ultimately hugely rewarding role. It will provide you with the opportunity to make a difference in over 1000 young adults' lives, giving something back to your community, and developing your skills in a board-level environment.

Applicants should have a passion for education and a commitment to the well-being of our students. The ideal candidate should:

- Be dedicated to promoting the highest educational standards.
- Demonstrate excellent teamwork and communication skills.
- Possesses strategic thinking and problem-solving abilities.
- Have a strong desire to contribute positively to our school community.

Previous Governor experience is not essential as support and training will be provided, but professional experience in finance or budgeting and/or education would be beneficial.

The successful applicant will attend two governing body board meetings per term, plus 1-2 committee meetings per term; which are held in the evenings, usually on Tuesdays. There will also be ad-hoc panel work to consider exclusions, complaints, and HR matters.
