Work Experience Opportunities

SB+CO Sustainability Work Experience – Strategy, Communications & Design (2 Days) Ages 16-19

A two-day immersive work experience programme with SB+CO, a London-based sustainability consultancy, where students will see first-hand how a real-world sustainability brief or challenge from a client moves from the high-level strategy and technical data insights process and is brought to life through to communications and creative design.

Day 1 – Strategy & Data

Students gain insight into how sustainability strategy is formed within businesses: how sustainability challenges are analysed, how data and insight are interpreted, and how clear, structured recommendations are built for clients. The day includes a welcome and introduction from SB+CO's strategy team, an icebreaker exploring sustainability concepts, framing of the day, and a research task in which students explore a real sustainability topic, identify key issues and data points, and build an initial view of the challenges and opportunities. After lunch, a re-energiser leads into students developing insights, interpreting data and shaping recommendations, finishing with individual five minute presentations to the SB+CO strategy team with feedback and Q&A.

Day 2 – Communications & Design

Students are introduced to sustainability communications and design – the bridge between technical strategy and tangible action. Building on Day 1, students will refine their outputs, simplify and structure messaging, and explore how to translate sustainability strategy into creative work that resonates with different stakeholders. The afternoon covers messaging segmentation for different audiences, storytelling, and visual communication principles, leading into a stakeholder challenge in which students choose a stakeholder (e.g. consumer, investor or policymaker) and rewrite their story for that audience. The day ends with final presentations focused on clarity, creativity and audience relevance.
