Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope you all have had a good week. Whilst we cannot believe it is Friday already, we know that with a sense of relief the assessment work for Year 11 and 13 will be concluded at the end of next week when we break for half term. The extensive quality assurance programme for student assessed grades then begins, with our teachers, subjects and the leadership team.

A few weeks ago, I mentioned that we had transferred our Management Information System (the system that holds all of the data about your child) to a new system called 'Arbor' and included in this system is a 'Parent Portal' and 'App' for both iOS and Android.

Both the App and Portal will enable parents to see and update vital information such as contact and medical details for your child/ren. The Arbor App allows you to receive real time information on various things. This includes:

- Attendance
- Academic reports
- Behaviour- Achievement, Consequences and detentions
- Trips & clubs
- Timetable

From September, we will be utilising the in-app messaging system. This allows us to send push messages about key information relating to your child. You will also have the ability to send messages via the Arbor App.

A welcome email will follow this newsletter. This will enable you to setup your account for your child. You will be asked to verify your child's data of birth to register.














An example from a demonstration school is shown below:
