What is SUB?

Skill Up Bucks is a programme that creates opportunities for students aged 17+ to meet and interact with employers. It aligns schools and colleges with local employers to provide a range of activities such as sector talks, employer visits, mentoring and work experience, helping you meet Gatsby benchmarks, particularly 5 and 6.

It nurtures local talent, develops employability skills and confidence and supports students to make the right decisions for their future.

Who delivers SUB?

Skill Up Bucks is delivered by careers charity Adviza and our partners Buckinghamshire New University, Support for Business and The Healthy Living Centre. The programme is funded by the European Social Fund and the Department for Work and Pensions.

The project uses a flexible delivery approach, delivering activities both at venues and remotely over video conferencing.

Skill Up Bucks is for anyone living in Bucks and aged 17+.
