Sax

I specialise in teaching jazz saxophone and for me this is what the saxophone is all about. The ABRSM Jazz Saxophone syllabus is excellent and even if students don't want to take exams it's a great resource to progress through. Students will learn using some of the greatest jazz standards of the 20th century and learn how to use jazz modes and improvisation.

**Piano** 

There are a variety of piano syllabuses that I teach ranging from ABRSM's Classical & Jazz syllabuses to Rockschool's Classical Piano, as well as their modern Piano & Keys syllabuses. I can also teach students to play using chords and playing by ear rather than reading traditional notation if this style suits them better.

Bass

I use Rockschool's syllabus to teach bass as it's a great resource even if students aren't interested in grades. Alongside or instead of that method I'm happy for students to learn any pieces they like as long as they're making progress.

**Drums** 

As with bass I use Rockschool's syllabus to teach drums as it's a great resource even if students aren't interested in grades. Alongside or instead of that method I'm happy for students to learn any pieces they like as long as they're making progress.
